

Sailing Policy

Weir Quay Sailing Club (Club) is a Community Amateur Sports Club and aims to provide sailing opportunities for all.

We recognise the Club has a responsibility to its members, and for that reason must hold sufficient personal details to allow appropriate and informed decisions to be made and to implement policies to ensure the safety of participants.

We aim to run our sailing sessions in line with Royal Yachting Association (RYA) guidance ensuring our activities are risk assessed, instructors and helpers are appropriately qualified, and Data Barring Service (DBS) checked, if working with young people and vulnerable adults.

We will support members to gain qualifications and to help deliver sailing activities. The Club will develop and support sailing activities for its members from our site on the River Tamar, and elsewhere as appropriate from time to time.

This policy and its associated procedures apply to sailing activities at Weir Quay and run by the Club and will be reviewed every year, or sooner if legislation changes demand.
