DINGHY EVENTS

Adequate personal buoyancy must be worn at all times. For latest news see Events page on club website.

SUPPORT BOATS

Support Boat helms and crew must have appropriate and indate qualifications and experience. In particular, the helm must have an RYA Safety Boat qualification.

The Support Boats must not be helmed unaccompanied.

The helm is responsible for the preparation of the Support Boat and for its operation.
